The show, which goes on for a fortnight, showcases work by design graduates across 11 disciplines. Each week features a different design selection: Part One includes ceramics & glass, applied arts and textiles while Part Two is dedicated

to furniture, spatial and graphic design.

This year, New Designers is also hosting Exposure, showcasing the work of 48 newly established designers who will be selling direct to the visitor.

Exposure will run across both weeks, while in the first week of the show, the Crafts Council will be presenting One Year On, focusing on a selection of designer

makers who have been in business for a year or less.
